

Arctic air pollution workshop: pollution sources and environmental impact 3-4 June 2019, Milan, Italy



The idea of the workshop is to evaluate the experience gained during the pilot study performed in Svalbard in 2018 and discuss plans on air pollution research in the Arctic.
